Tips For Fan Comfort

In the summer or in hotter weather, operate the fan in the normal direction (counterclockwise). This creates a cooling breeze below the fan. The thermostat may be raised, resulting in reduced energy consumption.

In winter, operate the fan speed in reverse direction. This redistributes the trapped warm air at the ceiling to provide even heat throughout the room. The thermostat may then be lowered for more efficient energy consumption.
